

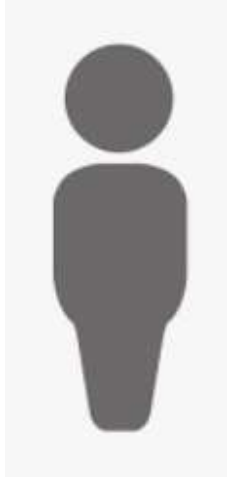
GUARDIANSHIP

IN A GUARDIANSHIP, THE PERSON WHO NEEDS HELP IS CALLED THE 'WARD'

THE PERSON WHO HELPS IS CALLED THE 'GUARDIAN'.

THE GUARDIAN TAKES CARE OF THE **PERSON** OF THE WARD, AND IS APPOINTED BY THE COURT TO MAKE DECISIONS REGARDING THE HEALTH AND WELFARE OF THE WARD.

A GUARDIAN HAS AUTHORITY TO MAKE PERSONAL DECISIONS ON BEHALF OF THE WARD, SUCH AS WHERE TO LIVE, EDUCATION, AND MEDICAL DECISIONS.

CONSERVATORSHIP

IN A CONSERVATORSHIP, THE PERSON WHO NEEDS HELP IS CALLED THE 'PROTECTED PERSON'.

THE PERSON WHO HELPS IS CALLED THE 'CONSERVATOR'.

THE CONSERVATOR TAKES CARE OF THE **ESTATE** OF THE PROTECTED PERSON, AND MAKES FINANCIAL DECISIONS FOR THE PROTECTED PERSON.

A CONSERVATOR HAS AUTHORITY OVER THE ESTATE OF THE PROTECTED PERSON AND WILL MAKE DECISIONS ABOUT MONEY AND PROPERTY FOR THE PROTECTED PERSON.
